OCAD - Access Copyright License

OCAD University has a license with the Canadian Copyright Licensing Agency (Access Copyright) that gives OCAD permission to make copies of many copyright-protected works for use by students, faculty and staff within certain limits. The license primarily gives permission for paper-to-paper copying, although certain other technologies are also specified in the license. It gives OCAD the authority to make copies beyond the "fair dealing" rights that exist for all users under copyright law, and provides easy and comprehensive clearance for a large proportion of copying.

The OCAD license is based on a model license negotiated with Access Copyright (formerly known as CanCopy) by the Association of Universities and Colleges of Canada. AUCC also provides general information about copyright in Canadian universities. The current license is effective from September 1, 2003, through August 31, 2010.

By signing the Access Copyright license, OCAD provides indemnity from civil claims so long as the members of the community comply with the provisions of the license. **The University will not accept responsibility for breaches of the license committed by faculty, staff or students of the University**, and in the event the University is found liable, the University reserves its right to claim contribution and indemnity over and against such person or persons who have breached the terms of the license.
