Anniversary Gallery



The Anniversary Gallery is a small venue that opened in 2014 celebrating the Sharp Centre for Design. The interior of this small gallery has glass walls, behind which two-dimensional and small three-dimensional works can be displayed safely without a gallery monitor being present.

The gallery entrance utilizes the interactive sculpture created by Design faculty member Gord Peteran. Titled *Inbox*, it was originally commissioned by Onsite Gallery in 2009.

Mandate

Located beside the Great Hall of OCAD University (100 McCaul St.), the Anniversary Gallery services the OCAD U community by supporting student exhibitions and public presentation labs. The gallery is available for experimental, process and course work from students in all OCAD U programs. First-time exhibitors are encouraged to use this space as a learning opportunity and a chance to collaborate, see work by students in other areas of study and gain experience in exhibiting. As a non-curated space, it may be booked for exhibitions by undergraduate and/or graduate students in all areas of study.

Allocation of exhibitions in the Anniversary Gallery are facilitated through the Anniversary Gallery Monitor for two week exhibition periods. Preference is given to first time exhibitors who demonstrate a readiness and ability to exhibit, and exhibitions are granted in an effort to provide representation for all areas of study at OCAD U. All exhibits must feature two or more students, and students are responsible for coordinating their group proposal.

The Anniversary Gallery accepts proposals of all media from OCAD U students, including undergraduate and graduate students in all programs. Students who wish to put forward a curatorial proposal are also encouraged to submit. Exhibitions are selected on a non-curated, first-come first-serve basis by the Anniversary Gallery Monitor with support from staff at the OCAD U Student Gallery. Submissions are accepted on an ongoing basis.

Submission guidelines

Approved hanging materials are finishing nails, tacks, pins, clips, or picture hangers. Any specialized hanging tools required should be supplied by the artists. We do not allow adhesives to be used.

Work must be installed in the Anniversary Gallery at the agreed upon time. After the exhibition, work must be taken down and the walls returned to their original condition (holes patched and paint touched up if needed). A set of basic tools as well as paint, painting tools, and spackle will be provided.

Students interested in planning to exhibit in the Anniversary Gallery should contact the Anniversary Gallery Monitor with potential dates of interest, program of study and year level, and the items outlined below:

Applicants are asked to provide the following items*:

- 1. Brief Project Description:** The project description should give a clear and concrete description of the work you are proposing for installation at the Anniversary Gallery. This should include the approximate number of pieces to be installed, and the media and theme(s) of the work.
- 2. Technical Description (up to 250 words):** The technical description should include a list of all foreseeable technical requirements including equipment and materials necessary for installation within the Anniversary Gallery, such as plinths, audio equipment, or additional lighting.
- 3. Visual Support Material (5-10):** Images must be in JPG format (under 1 MB each). You may include links to video and/or audio files. These should be a maximum of 3-5 minutes in total. If there is a specific portion of a longer video you would like the Anniversary Gallery Monitor to watch, please indicate it on your support material list. Please keep in mind that OCAD U email addresses will reject emails over 8 MB. Please use an online service, such as dropbox, if needed for large files.

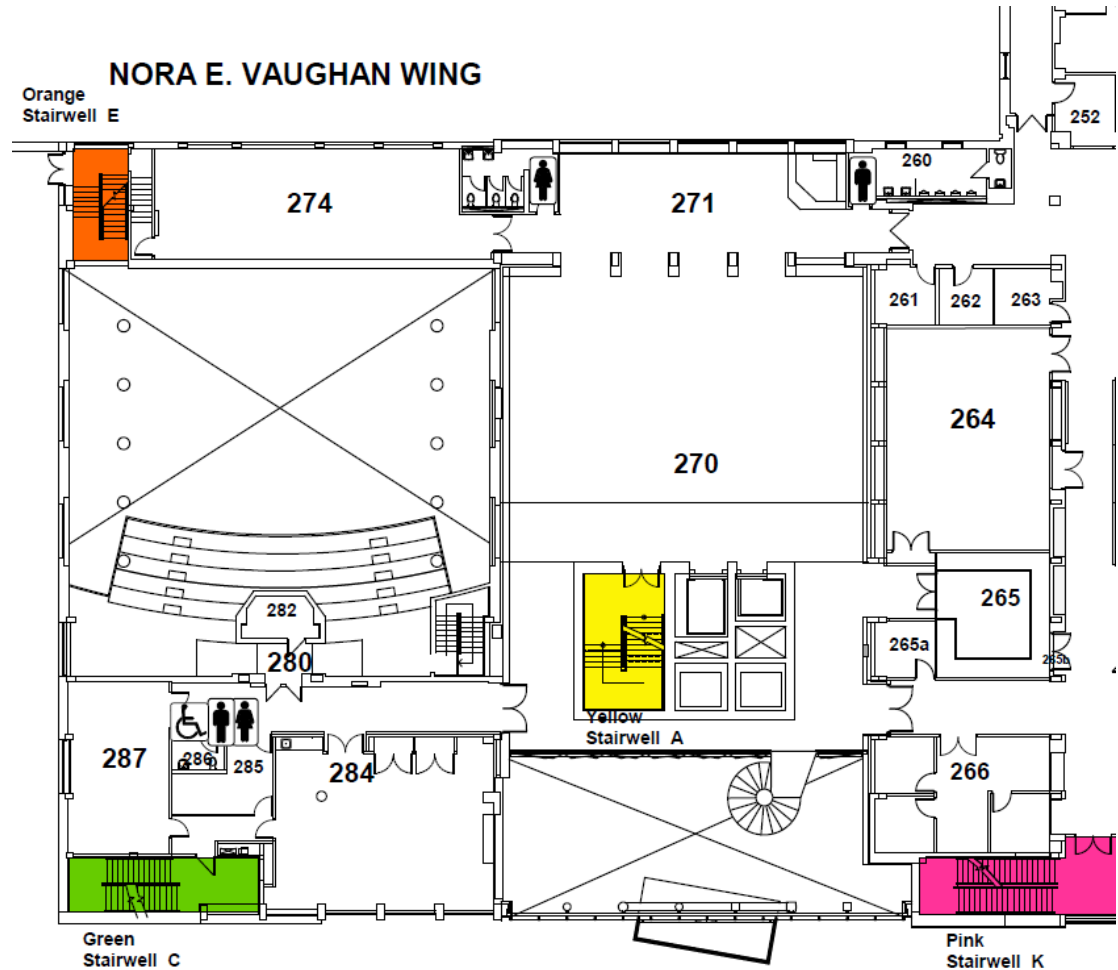
