## To Start

1. go to Library Homepage
1. click DATABASES A – Z
2. select Eureka.CC

## To Search

1. select Advanced Search
2. type search term(s)
  - in box OR
  - use boxes with
3. select search fields or **where** you terms will be searched

### OPTIONAL LIMITS

- use buttons to use Boolean Operator:
  - **and** (to limit results)
  - **or** (to expand results)
  - **without** (to not search a term)
- select specific newspaper(s)
- select date range(s)

## To View Results

- click title to view full text article; article will appear in lower right window

### NOTE

- use full screen icon to expand size of article for easier reading
