

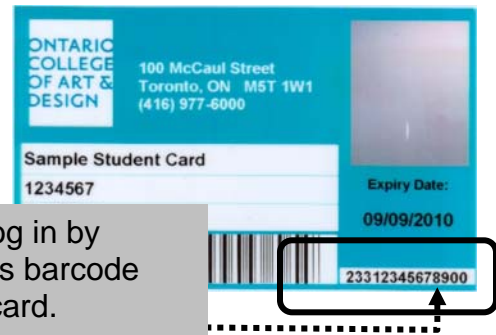
# MLA International Bibliography

@ DOROTHY H. HOOVER LIBRARY

Citations and abstracts (descriptions) for scholarly articles from over 4,400 journals. Includes articles from 1963 to the present. Subjects cover literature, language, linguistics, and folklore. **Note: most articles are not Full Text**

## To Start

1. go to Library Homepage
  2. click DATABASES link
    - log into AAgent (see AAgent Search Guide for more information)
- OR
- select MLA Bibliography from DATABASES A-Z



**Off Campus?** log in by entering 14 digits barcode from OCAD ID card.

Will look up both British and U.S. spellings

1. enter search terms in one of more of the boxes

2. Select **Search Fields** from drop down menus

<b>Words Anywhere</b>	searches all fields from each record (Keyword search)
<b>Subject</b>	retrieves information about topics
<b>Author as Subject</b>	retrieves works <b>about</b> an author
<b>Literary Theme</b>	search for archetypal topics in literature (exile, fear, love, etc.)
<b>Genre</b>	search by type of literature (fiction, myths, etc.)

### 3. Select **Connectors**

<b>AND</b>	finds records with <b>all</b> terms searched	<b>limits</b> your search
<b>OR</b>	finds <b>any</b> of the terms searched; functions as "and/or"	<b>expands</b> your search
<b>NOT</b>	terms following this connector are not searched	<b>limits</b> your search

### 4. **OPTIONAL:** limit your search by Language of Article; Document Type (book, book article, journal article, etc.); Publication Year; Peer-Review

### 5. Click **Search**

## To Revise a Search

- then re-enter term(s) in search box(es). Try new terms or search options, such as:

If you have <b>too many</b> records:	If you have <b>too few</b> :
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>add more terms to search box</li> <li>use AND to connect terms</li> <li>use less general terms (e.g. instead of "modern," try specific genres like "fauvism," "cubism," "expressionsim")</li> <li>search using Subject (not Words Anywhere)</li> <li>limit to peer-reviewed articles only</li> <li>limit by dates</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>delete one or more terms</li> <li>use OR to connect terms</li> <li>use an asterisk ( * ) at the end of a term for variants of a root word</li> <li>think of other terms that may be more appropriate (e.g. instead of "naive art," try "folk art" or "outsider art.")</li> <li>check spelling of authors' names using the Encyclopedia of Literature</li> </ul>
