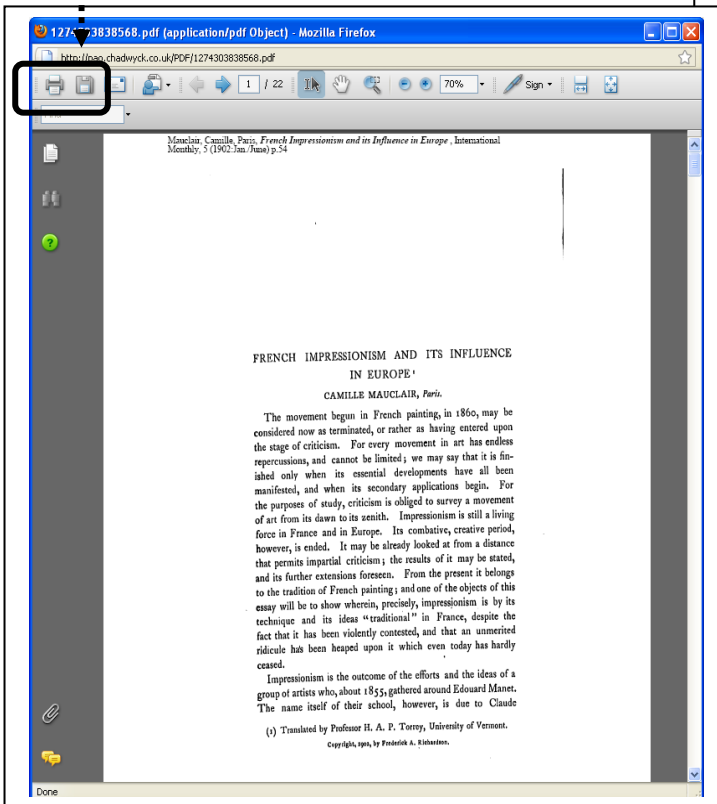
Recommended limits:

- Year of Publication
- Language(s)

- click PDF icon for full text
 - use box to save citation(s) for bibliography
 - select **Marked List** to email citations
- use icons to **print** or **save** document



To Revise Search

- select **Modify Search**
- revise search terms or strategy:

If you have **too many** records

- add** more terms to search
- use less **general** terms
 - e.g. instead of "modern" try specific styles "fauvism," "cubism," "minimalism," etc.

If you have **too few**

- delete** one or more terms
- use an **asterisk (*)** at the end of a term
 - e.g. canad* will search Canada, Canadian, Canda's,
- use **encyclopedia** (*Grove Dictionary of Art*) to:
 - check spelling of names
 - for **related** terms: e.g. instead of "naïve art," try "folk art," or "outsider art."
