1. Enter search term(s)
2. More than one keyword? try separating them with:
  - AND to **limit** results
  - OR to **expand** results
  - NOT to **delete** a search term (e.g. Canada NOT Ontario)
  - searching a phrase? use quotation marks
3. Select **Journals**
4. click

## To View Results

Click:

- HTML or PDF for **full text** article
- title of journal for **abstract** (brief description)
- **boxes** to limit your search by
  - subject
  - author (of article)
  - category

## To Revise

Not finding what you need?

- click **Modify Search**

## Too many articles?

- add more terms
- use more specific geographic areas, time periods, or groups of people
- use the **Title** or **Research Area** fields

## Too few?

- If you have limited your search to Title or Research Area, try searching in **Content**
- use synonyms, plurals and word variations
- check for spelling mistakes or typing errors.

## To Download

To email articles:

1. access PDF version
2. save a copy (use **File** menu—**Save As...PDF**)
3. email the PDF as an attachment

To print or save a copy:

1. access PDF version
2. use icons provided (or **File** menu)
