Submission Guidelines

- Submissions from all areas within OCAD University's twelve disciplines will be considered
***if submitted on time with a complete package and application*
- A maximum of five (5) works may be submitted via CD or DVD using .jpg formats for still works and .mpg or .mov formats for video or electronic works
- Submissions must work across both MAC and PC systems
- 2-D work should be no larger than 30"x30"x3" and 3-D work should be no larger than 10"x10"x30" (L x W x H)
- Include a clear, concise list of proposed works, including title, medium, dimensions, year and price. A maximum of two (2) works may be selected
- Submissions will not be returned unless accompanied by a self-addressed, postage-paid envelope
- All works selected for exhibition must be delivered ready to hang or install, with all necessary hardware and materials (this includes displays for video works and components for any electronic media, and plinths for 3-D works)
- By submitting an application, you agree that if selected to exhibit, your work may be reproduced for promotional and marketing efforts in advance of the exhibition and also beyond for a period of at least five years. These materials will not benefit the Alumni Association financially and will serve only to promote the exhibition
- Include a brief biography – maximum of 250 words – including years attended and program of study
- Upon delivery of accepted works, a complete contract will be available
- Dates are subject to change, but participants will be notified at time of selection

Fees

- \$25 non-refundable submission fee must accompany all applications
- 40% commission on work sold will apply
