OCAD Student Gallery

The **OCAD Student Gallery** is committed to the professional exhibition of contemporary art and design by students of the university. This educational opportunity teaches students to coordinate a gallery submission and, if their proposal is accepted, to mount an exhibition in a gallery, and to write a professional artists' statement and curriculum vitae. The gallery endeavours to represent all disciplines through a program of curated exhibitions. The general public, art and OCAD communities are made aware of emerging artists and designers.

The **OCAD Student Gallery** is located at 285 Dundas Street W., 1st floor, just east of Dundas & McCaul. Gallery hours are Wednesday to Saturday, 12 to 6 pm, or by appointment. Student submissions are reviewed by a Selection Committee each year in the summer, comprising the Student Gallery/Transit Space staff, faculty, students, and a professional artist, designer or curator. All exhibits feature a minimum of four students. Students are welcome to apply individually, and be curated into a group show or curate their own exhibit.

The OCAD Student Gallery is currently programmed through May 2011.

Transit Space

Located at the entrance to Central Hall at 100 McCaul Street, Level 2, **Transit Space** is a non-curated group exhibit venue which may be booked by students or faculty for exhibitions.

Allocation of exhibitions in **Transit Space** is facilitated through the Student Gallery/Transit Space Advisory Board for three week exhibition periods. Preference is given to exhibitors who demonstrate a readiness and ability to exhibit. As well, exhibitions are granted in an effort to provide representation for all areas of study at OCAD. Students are responsible for coordinating their group proposal and exhibits must include a minimum of four students.
