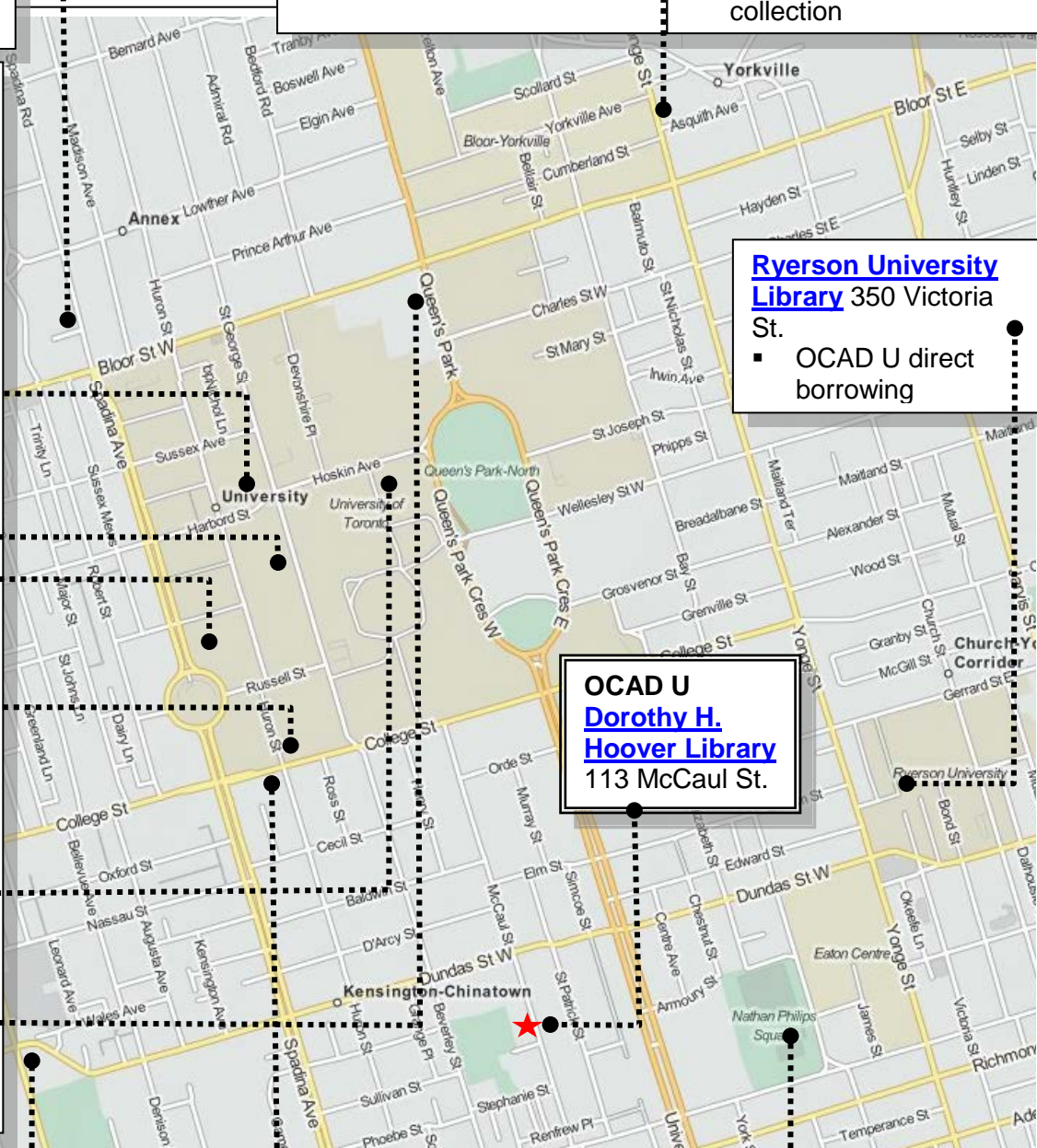

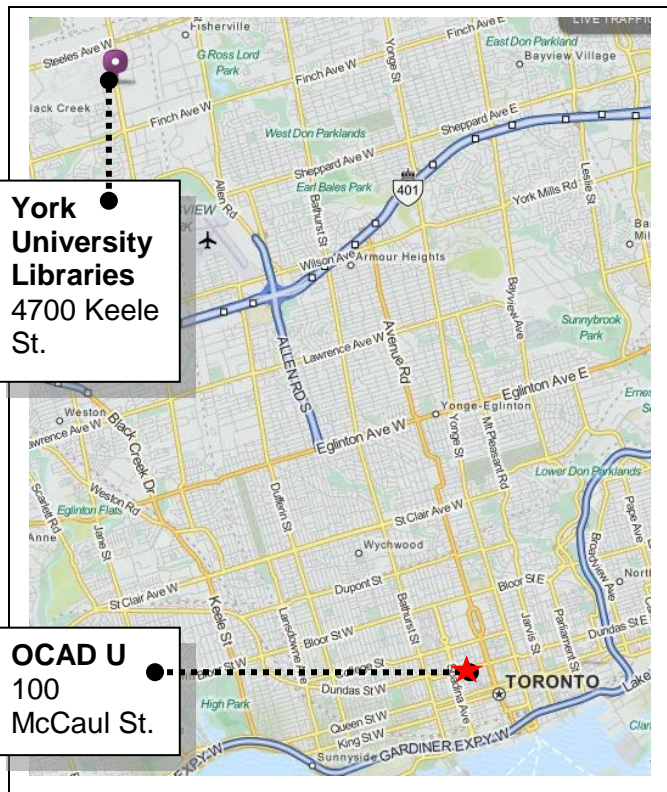

Direct Borrowing

OCAD U Students can borrow items from any Canadian university library (except those in the University of Toronto system or at Quebec universities) or from public libraries.

- Toronto Public Library – you must show **proof of residency** in the greater Toronto area (driver's license, a bill or letter sent to your address, etc.) to obtain a library card. Cards can be acquired at any branch
- University Libraries – you must present a **valid OCAD U ID card** at the main library branch to receive a **Direct Borrower's Card**.



Use [RACER Online Inter-Library Loans](#) to borrow circulating books from most libraries in Canada (including from the University of Toronto) or from selected U.S. or U.K. libraries
