

## Illustration (Minor) – 2024/2025 Program Guide

A minor in Illustration provides a general introduction to Illustration, and is intended for students with intermediate to advanced drawing competencies from the following Major programs:

- Advertising
- Graphic Design
- Drawing & Painting (including Digital Painting and Expanded Animation)
- Printmaking & Publications

Students from alternate programs require the permission of the Illustration Chair and should contact the Faculty of Design office at [designoffice@ocadu.ca](mailto:designoffice@ocadu.ca) to arrange an appointment.

Not all courses are offered every year. Students are required to meet the pre-requisites for entry into all courses.

**Courses required for a Major program may not be applied to a minor. At least 1.0 credit of the minor must be at the 3000 or 4000 level.**
