2022-2023 TEACHING AWARDS CRITERIA

CRITERIA FOR THE PRICE, NON-TENURED AND FACULTY AWARDS:

- **1.** Forwards the Academic Plan commitments to decolonization, equity, access and sustainability through course materials and practices
- 2. Cultivates a student-centered, inclusive learning environment that supports student wellness
- **3.** Develops effective pedagogical techniques or innovations that enhance student engagement, creativity, critical thinking, and learning

ADDITIONAL CRITERIA FOR THE PRICE AND NON-TENURED AWARDS:

In addition to criteria 1 - 3 above, candidates for the Price and Non-Tenured (institutional level) awards will be considered based on the following criteria:

- **4.** Adopts a leadership role or provides leadership through example within the program, Faculty and institution
- **5.** Builds sustained and reciprocal relationships and collaborations with communities within and beyond OCAD University

TEACHING ASSISTANT AWARD CRITERIA:

- 1. Provides exemplary support to the faculty member
- 2. Effectively utilizes student resources for learning
- 3. Aids in the development of student skills to support their academic success
- 4. Communicates clearly and concisely in person and online
- **5.** Creates a learning environment that values diverse languages, literacies and ways of knowing and communicating
